HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES POLICY STATEMENT

This policy statement recognises that the health and safety of all employees using hazardous substances within THE POSITRON GROUP is the responsibility of the POSITRON GROUP management. In fulfilling this responsibility, management has a duty to provide and maintain a working environment that is safe and without risk to health.

ALL THE POSITRON GROUP Management is responsible to ensure that the following requirements are satisfied:

- Identify and assess all hazardous substances. This should be done by appropriately trained staff.
- Ensure that all hazardous substances used at work are provided with labels and material safety data sheets that conform to national standards.
- Minimise the risk of adverse health and safety effects due to exposure to hazardous substances in the workplace.
- Maintain information in the form of a hazardous substances register and other records as specified in the regulations.
- Ensure that employees with potential for exposure to hazardous substances used in work activity are provided with education and training on the nature of the hazards and the means of assessing and controlling exposure to workplace hazardous substances.
- Ensure that emergency services and other relevant public authorities have access to relevant information on workplace hazardous substances.

In fulfilling the objectives of this Hazardous Substances Management Policy, management is committed to regular consultation with employees to ensure that the policy operates effectively and that health and safety issues are regularly reviewed.
